Luc Besson's Arthur 3: The War of the Two Worlds is a 2010 French-American 3D live action/animated fantasy adventure film directed by Luc Besson and starring Freddie Highmore, Mia Farrow, Mads Mikkelsen, and David Thewlis. It is the third and final installment in the Arthur series.

The film begins with the voice of Merlin (voiced by Patrick Stewart) narrating the story of the war between the humans and the Minimoy, which began when the humans built a dam that flooded the Minimoy's homeland. The Minimoy's king, Caspian (played by Highmore), asked for help from Arthur (played by Highmore), a human boy who had previously helped them in their fight against the evil Maltazard (played by Mikkelsen).
